Action Taken Report on Feedback Analysis

Based on the feedback received from students on various institutional facilities, the following corrective and improvement measures have been initiated by the College of Pharmacy to enhance overall academic and support infrastructure.

A. Library Facilities

Parameter	Action Taken
Library Timing	Library timing will be extended during examination periods. Additional arrangements for early morning and late evening access will be considered. Weekend access will also be reviewed to improve student convenience.
Availability of Titles	Additional copies of high-demand textbooks will be procured. Latest editions of subject books and additional reference books, including competitive examination materials (GPAT, NIPER, etc.), will be added to the library collection.
Cataloguing and Arrangement	Library cataloguing will be further improved through better shelf management and clear labeling of book sections. Periodic verification and re-arrangement of shelves will be conducted.
Reading Space	Existing reading space will be maintained properly. Efforts will be made to optimize seating arrangements during peak academic periods.
Library Staff Support	Library staff will continue to provide cooperative assistance. Periodic orientation will be conducted to maintain high service standards.

Parameter	Action Taken
Availability of Computers	Regular monitoring of computer laboratories will be conducted to ensure all systems remain functional. Additional computers may be added in future based on student strength.
Internet/Wi-Fi Connectivity Availability of Computers	Internet bandwidth will be periodically reviewed and upgraded if required to maintain smooth academic access.
